Lac Boulevard (plage principale)

Boulevard Lake is a human-made lake that is fed by the Current River and flows into Lake Superior. Take a look at the Black Bay Bridge, the first bridge of its kind to be built in North America over 100 years ago. Take the 5km challenge and travel around the lake which you can do by foot, bike or in-line skating.
